TIME COMMITMENT: One semester to one year
RESPONSIBLE TO: 4-H SET Program Representative
RESPONSIBLE FOR: Delivery of the 4-H SET (Science, Engineering, and Technology) program to elementary school students in an after-school program for approximately one hour, weekly or biweekly and/or at events

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Desire and ability to work with elementary school children
• Willingness to work as part of a team
• Time to give 1-3 hours weekly/biweekly to the project
• Enthusiasm for the project and openness to learn

SPECIFIC TASKS:

- Attend approximately 10 hours of SET training
• Meet with and/or contact site team to plan and organize science sessions
• Be committed to the program
• Come prepared to teach hands-on science activities to the students at sites
• Be encouraging and establish relationships with students
• Regularly communicate with SET program representative and site team to assess and evaluate program/experience at site
